- ▶ Identify the prevalence of abuse against people with disabilities.
- ▶ Identify types of victimization against people with disabilities.
- ▶ Define sexual assault.
- ▶ Define domestic violence.  
Identify both physical and social barriers leading to independence.
- ▶ Identify signs of victimization; physical, financial, behavioral, environmental.
- ▶ Identify *best practices* for safety Planning.
- ▶ Demonstrate *best practices* regarding documentation for prosecution.
- ▶ Demonstrate effective strategies for responding to disclosures of victimization/abuse.
- ▶ Explain available community resources for victim assistance.
- ▶ Demonstrate the use of visual supports to assist people with intellectual impairments.
- ▶ Demonstrate the components of a individualized safety plan.
- ▶ Create a sample "Safety Plan Kit."
- ▶ Identify the role of the SLP in assisting potential victims.
- ▶ Identify the role of the Social Worker and/or Counselor in assisting potential victims.
